

POLICY

SUBJECT: Alcohol and Drugs
--

The Lambton Kent District School Board recognizes that many individuals require prescription drugs, used under the authority of a physician, or over the counter medicines, to maintain their health, or combat disease.

The Board prohibits the illegal and irresponsible use of alcohol and drugs by establishing preventative programs for employees, preventative curriculum for students, early intervention measure for both employees and students, and by administering, when deemed necessary, disciplinary actions in accordance with federal and provincial laws and regulations.

Employees and students under the influence of alcohol and/or illegal drugs will either be removed from or will be refused admittance to Board facilities.

It is the policy of the Lambton Kent District School Board to prohibit the possession and use of alcohol and unauthorized drugs by students while on Board property or attending Board sponsored events, to prohibit the use of alcohol and unauthorized drugs by employees while on Board property, and to prohibit the establishment of bar facilities for serving alcoholic beverages in any of its schools.
