

REGULATIONS

SUBJECT: Kindergarten Program

1. The options available to Principals for structuring effective Kindergarten programs are:
 - a) segregated junior and senior kindergarten classes;
 - b) combined junior and senior kindergarten classes of multi-aged groups, which include both junior and senior kindergarten aged students in one class.
2. The time arrangements available to Principals for organizing effective Kindergarten programs are alternate days in the pattern of 2 constant days per week and alternating Fridays.
3. District registration dates for all Kindergarten programs will be identified by November of each calendar year and published by the Communications Officer through appropriate announcements.
4. Each Principal, in consultation with the school community, is responsible for designing a structured entry process that strives to meet the needs of all students entering the Kindergarten programs at the school, and for clearly communicating this process to all parent/guardians and teachers.
