

## PURPOSE

The late Gwendoline Isobella Charteris of the City of Chatham bequeathed a sum of money to fund an award described below under “Conditions of Award”.

## AWARD

A scholarship in an amount to be determined from the income of the fund will be given annually, commencing with the 1978 – 1979 academic year to a maximum of six years, providing that the recipient passes the annual examinations of the University or such other criteria in lieu of or in substitution for examinations. Otherwise, the recipient will be disqualified from the Award upon failure to pass the year. Should the Award be made to a recipient other than one entering the School of Medicine, the Foundation has the power to cancel the award should an applicant qualify in succeeding years under the first preference.

## CONDITIONS OF AWARD

- ❖ Any female graduate of Chatham-Kent Secondary School or John McGregor Secondary School, who will be attending full-time studies in the School of Medicine at the University of Toronto, or a required course antecedent thereto, immediately upon graduation.

NOTE: The Foundation shall give preference to a graduate noted above, but if, in a given year, no such graduate applies, will consider a graduate entering a course in some Science related to medicine. Failing that, consideration will be given to a proposed recipient in some Science course other than those mentioned previously.

- ❖ Must be of Protestant faith.
- ❖ Must be a resident of the area served by Chatham-Kent Secondary School or John McGregor Secondary School.

## APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- ❖ Applications must be submitted to the principal of the Secondary School from which the student graduated by June 1st of the year of graduation from the Secondary School. **(Please attach a most recent transcript of marks.)**
- ❖ Applications shall be made on a form as attached. These forms may be obtained from the Student Services Office of the public Secondary Schools in Chatham.
- ❖ The Administrator – Chatham-Kent Public Education Student Assistance Foundation will co-ordinate selection of the successful applicant.
- ❖ All applicants will be informed by June 30 whether or not they have been successful.
