The **Lambton Kent Agriculture in the Classroom Action Committee** is delighted to invite your school to *Harvest Days 2010*. Designed for the grade three students (*split classes are welcome*) from across Lambton Kent. This interactive ninety minute program has become a tradition for in raising awareness of Agriculture and Food in Lambton Kent while engaging students in education.

*Harvest Days* will take place on **September 28<sup>th</sup>, 29<sup>th</sup>, 30<sup>th</sup>, and October 1<sup>st</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>**. Students will be both entertained and educated! The program follows the grade three curriculums – from lessons on soil to early settlement experience.

Hands on learning that your class will remember long after you have returned to class!

The program runs twice a day beginning promptly at 10:15 am and 12:30 pm. Arrival time, 10:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. is fifteen minutes prior to your program start time so all groups can be organized and begin their tour on time. Your class will be split into smaller groups of approximately 12-15 so everyone will be able to actively participate in hands on activities.

This program is fully sponsored by the **Lambton-Kent Agriculture in the Classroom Action Committee**; there is no cost to you or the students. However, transportation to *Harvest Days* is the responsibility of the school.

Fax your registration sheet early because *Harvest Days* does fill quickly. We encourage you to do so even before the end of this school year and reserve your school's participation. Simply fill out the form provided on the registration brochure enclosed and send it back to us by mail or fax, then you and your grade three students will be set to explore *Harvest Days 2010*. A confirmation email will be sent now and an information package will be sent to you in early September with further details.
