General Course Information

- ✓ Students with the Lambton Kent District School Board or the St. Clair District School Board, or students in a board with membership in the Ontario eLearning Consortium, (<http://oelc.ca/>) are eligible to register providing he/she meets the program requirements.
- ✓ Listed courses will run pending sufficient enrollment.
- ✓ Students will be permitted to complete **one credit** during summer semester. **The only exception is for students eligible for Civics (CHV2O) and Career Studies (GLC2O).**
- ✓ Course material will be delivered in an e-Learning format.
- ✓ LKDSB and SCCDSB students are required to attend an orientation, and begin working on the course, at one of the Summer Semester locations - see Summer Semester Schedule
- ✓ Students from other boards will complete an online orientation.
- ✓ It is recommended that all students work from a Summer Semester location for the remainder of the program, but will have the option to work from home.
- ✓ Daily attendance will be taken via the e-Learning classroom.
- ✓ The Summer Semester sites will be open every day, during scheduled hours, allowing students to drop in for teacher assistance or to use computers.
- ✓ For courses with a final exam, LKDSB and SCCDSB students must write in one of the Summer Semester locations (JMSS or SCITS).
- ✓ Students from another board will write the exam under supervision and in a pre-determined location.

Registration Process

Students, parents and counsellors can view course offerings by clicking the link, "View the 2011-12 Course Offerings here".

1. Counsellors can register a student for a summer course via the Student Success eSolution (SSeS) web site.
2. Alternatively, an LKDSB student can apply for one course in the SSeS (exception CHV2O and GLC2O). The counsellor at the student's home school will then accept or decline the application within the SSeS, based on eligibility and pre-requisites and after consultation with the Principal or designate.

3. The registration deadline is June 29, 2012.

Summer Coop - Student Success

This program allows students entering grade 10, 11 and grade 12 to earn 1 or 2 credits through Cooperative Education and is designed for students who are behind in credit totals. Students are to be referred by Student Services or the Student Success Team in their home school. 110 hours per Coop Credit (to a maximum of 220 hours or 2 credits) plus completion of online assignments are required.

UPGRADE Courses

- ✓ Upgrade courses are a minimum of 55 hours. Course content has been chosen to ensure core concepts are delivered.
- ✓ Students who have passed a course but wish to upgrade their mark are eligible for an upgrading opportunity.
- ✓ For students who have not successfully completed a course, eligibility is determined by the administration of the home school.
