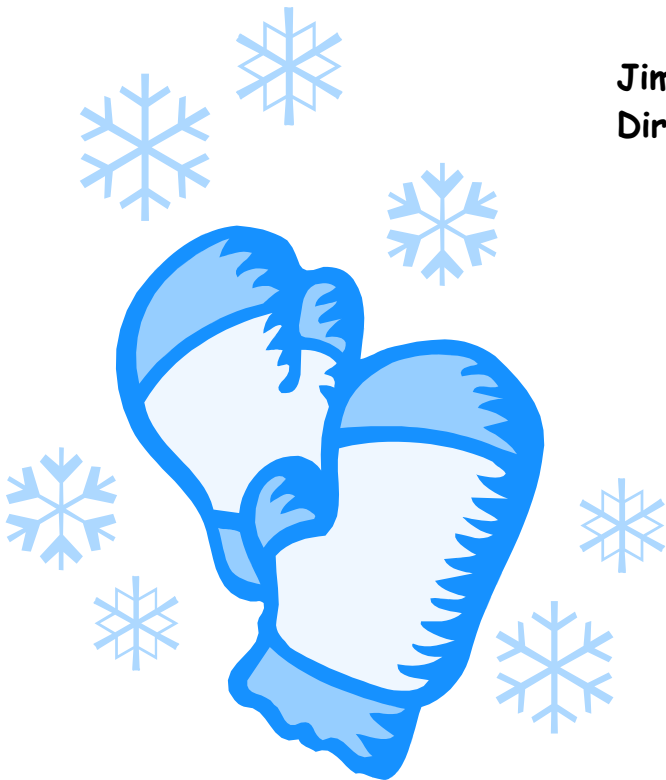

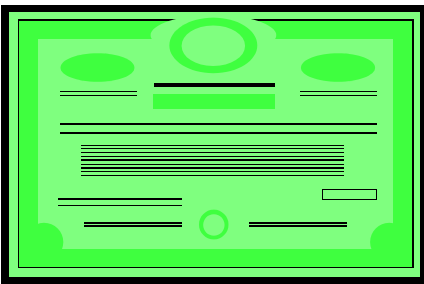
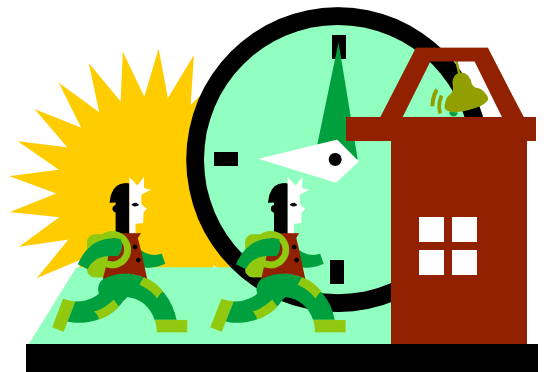


REFRESHMENTS

How to Access?

- ☛ Access the program through Internet Explorer at <https://pd.lkdsb.net> (from home or at school).

How to Log In?

- ☛ Type in your GroupWise **username**, which is the first 6 letters of your surname and the first 2 letters of your first name.
- ☛ Type in your **Password**. This is your employee ID number which can be found on the top left hand corner of your pay stub.
- ☛ You will now be on the "Workshop" page.

Workshop Page

- ☛ There are 5 ways you can search and register for a workshop

1. Select "Browse Upcoming Workshops" for a listing of all available workshops.
2. Type in the workshop title and click "Submit".
3. Click on a link to a "Specific Workshop" to view workshops offered for a specific target group.
4. If you know the workshop number, you can do a "Search" by typing the workshop number in the search box at the top and click on "Search".
5. Select "Advanced Search". You will be able to search for a workshop by filling in any of the information requested.

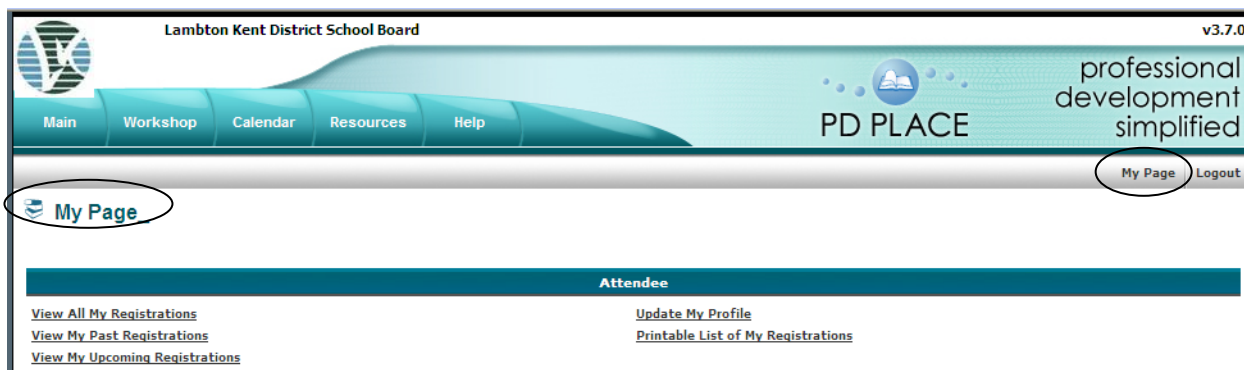
