BOARD ELECTS CHAIR AND VICE-CHAIR FOR 2010

SARNIA - At the December 1, 2009 Annual Organization Meeting, the Board of Trustees for the Lambton Kent District School Board elected Carmen McGregor as Chair of the Board and Jane Bryce as Vice-Chair of the Board.

Chair McGregor, has served as a school board trustee since 2004 and represents the area of North Kent and South Lambton (Dawn-Euphemia, Dresden, Chatham Township, Wallaceburg and Dover).
