Re: French Immersion Program Review Interim Report

BACKGROUND:

French Immersion is an optional program that Boards of Education may choose to offer. French Immersion is offered at eight combined elementary sites and three secondary schools across the Lambton Kent District School Board. However, with the continuing declining enrolment in the Lambton Kent District School Board, the viability of maintaining each of these sites has arisen. A French Immersion Review Committee was therefore struck in the fall of 2009 to review the current delivery model.

The committee met throughout the 2009-10 school year and into this fall.

CURRENT DELIVERY MODEL:

Schools:

Presently, the following LKDSB schools offer French Immersion:

All French Immersion sites within the Lambton Kent District School Board are dual-track schools. Dual-track schools offer both French Immersion and English programs.

Program Delivery:

Elementary students enrolled in French Immersion receive instruction as follows:

JK – Gd.2 100% French
 Gd.3 – 8 50% English/50% French

Secondary students have two graduation options:

Certificate in French Immersion Studies 10 French Immersion courses
 Certificate in Extended French Studies 7 French Immersion courses

Transportation:

In 2006, criteria for transportation to French Immersion programs were established by CLASS (Chatham-Kent Lambton Administrative School Services) to clarify and formalize eligibility of participants. The Board provides transportation to French Immersion programs for up to 20 kilometres for Elementary students and up to 40 kilometres for Secondary students.

STUDY:

The French Immersion Review Committee considered a number of factors in the current program delivery model of French Immersion:

- Student achievement
- Entry point into program
- Resource support
- Procedures re: entry into program, out-of-boundary students, family enrolment
- Enrolment
- Funding

STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT:

With the exception of the Primary Reading Assessment, elementary students enrolled in the French Immersion program perform as well or better academically than their peers in the English program as measured by the recent Primary and Junior EQAO assessments. The 2009-10 EQAO results are outlined in the chart below:

Secondary students enrolled in French Immersion courses are reported to be high achievers.

ENTRY POINT into FRENCH IMMERSION PROGRAM:

As French Immersion is an optional program, there is not a standardized mode of program delivery across the province. Research into other Districts’ models revealed a variety of entry points into the program as well as delivery models (% of French instruction).

A Ministry revision of the French Immersion curriculum is currently occurring. Three program entry points are being proposed with this revision:

- Early Immersion Grade 1 with flexibility to start before Grade 1
- Middle Immersion Grade 4
- Late Immersion Grade 7

RESOURCE SUPPORT:

In the 2009-10 school year, forty-two students in the French Immersion program were identified with special needs. Eighteen of these students were identified with the identification of “giftedness.” In surveying the schools, only three sites were able to offer French Immersion students resource support in the French language.

PROCEDURES:

The committee proposed that the following procedures be aligned re: enrolment into the French Immersion program:

- October 1st of Grade 1 is the latest that a student could enter the F.I. program. Mitigating circumstances for entering in a later grade could be if the student came from a Francophone background or had a functional knowledge of the French language.
- Only students registered in the French Immersion program could attend an out-of-boundary dual-track school. (Siblings would not automatically be accepted into the English program of the school.)
- Students in secondary French Immersion program could attend any French Immersion secondary school but are not guaranteed transportation.

Elementary Enrolment:

Appendix A outlines the enrolment history of French Immersion in each elementary school since 2000. Observations include the small number of students in some grades and classes at some sites. As well, a decline in enrolment of students as they progress through the grades is evident at some sites.

Appendix B includes the 2010 – 11 class organizations for each dual-track elementary school. Observations include the marked difference in the number of students in some French Immersion classes compared to those in English classes. Primary classes are somewhat similar in numbers due to the Ministry-imposed Primary “cap”.

The average class size for all Primary classes is 20 students. For all Junior and Intermediate classes, 24.8 is the average class size. The following chart outlines the average elementary French Immersion class size by school during the 2009-10 school year.

FUNDING:

Elementary classroom teachers in French Immersion classes are funded through the *School Foundation Grant* as well as the *French Immersion Grant for Classroom Teachers*. The total French Immersion classroom teacher expense above the *School Foundation Grant* is \$1 080 185.00. The chart below outlines the net unfunded cost of French Immersion classroom teacher expenditures for the 2009-10 school year:

ISSUES IDENTIFIED:

The main issues facing the current French Immersion Program delivery model have been identified as:

1. The challenge of maintaining a critical mass of students in each site to ensure a viable program.
2. The funding shortfall.
3. A considerable cost to the Transportation Department if the catchment areas were expanded.
4. Resource support in the French language is not available at each dual-track school.

NEXT STEPS:

1. That the Board reduce the number of dual-track sites due to the funding implications of the current model. The French Immersion programs at Brooke, Hillcrest/Petrolia, Sir John Moore and Harwich Raleigh would be phased out beginning in the 2011-12 school year. Students currently enrolled in these programs would be allowed to complete their French Immersion programs.
2. That the Board consider a middle or late immersion delivery model in future years in the rural areas of the District.
3. That the Board consolidate the French Immersion School sites in the City of Sarnia.
4. That the Board consider the possible creation of a single-track French Immersion school in Sarnia and Chatham-Kent if warranted by enrolment and providing program funding could sustain the program.
