Clarification Regarding Funding of Late Buses at LCCVI

The Board has received many emails from people in the (Lambton Central Collegiate & Vocational Institute) LCCVI community expressing concern about the cancellation of the late buses at the school.

The Lambton Kent District School Board receives transportation funding to provide bus rides for eligible riders to transport them to and from school each day. Neither the Ministry of Education nor the Lambton Kent District School Board provides funds for late bus transportation.

The LCCVI late buses have been funded by a generous private donor. Both LCCVI and the school community are thankful for this past opportunity. For a number of reasons this private donor is no longer able to provide the funding and the school has not been able to generate the necessary funding to continue this service. Principal Warner has been consistently communicating this information to the school community for the past couple of years and sharing the information in newsletters that can be found on the LCCVI website <http://lccvi.lkdsb.net>.

The Board's practice has not changed. The Board receives transportation funding to provide bus rides for eligible riders to transport them to and from school each day.

The Board appreciates the support expressed for the excellent programs and educational opportunities provided for the LCCVI students.
