#### Secondary Student Success Audit

Our Board is one of three school boards in the province randomly selected to participate in a secondary Student Success audit conducted by the office of the Auditor General of Ontario. The Auditor General will be sending six staff to work with Bert Phills, Superintendent of Education-Student Achievement Secondary, Ron Andruchow, Superintendent of Business, Lorie Vandeschoot, Planning and Reporting Officer and other support staff. The audit requires a significant amount of time to gather the required information prior to the visit. The Auditor's team will arrive March 29 and be here for two weeks. The purpose of the audit is to determine that the Ministry of Education has allocated the funding to the Board appropriately and that the Board has spent the funding appropriately.
