Introduction

This publication seeks to outline the major sources of financial assistance available to local students who are pursuing post-secondary education.

Various donors review the conditions and amounts of their awards at different times in the calendar year and distribute their application materials accordingly; hence current information may change after the printing of this publication.

Students must assume the responsibility of making application for the various awards listed in this booklet.

Sources of Financial Assistance

There are a variety of sources available to students looking for financial assistance. Students should consider any or all of the following:

Using this Resource Efficiently

1. To maintain eligibility for any of the awards in this publication, students must complete the Supplementary Information Form for College and University Bound Students. (See Appendix I.) This is distributed by Student Services at each secondary school and the deadline for its return is clearly outlined on the form.
2. The CHART on pages 5-10, lists in alphabetical order ALL AWARDS detailed in this publication and identifies each according to its status* as scholarship or bursary, its use for college or university attendance, and its availability to specific secondary schools, when such is the case.
* *Scholarships are normally granted on the basis of a student's academic achievement, while bursaries are normally granted on the basis of a student's financial need.*
3. The SOURCES OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE section on page 2 suggests the procedures to be considered by any student seeking financial assistance for post-secondary education.
4. The OSAP (Ontario Student Assistance Program) section on page 4, describes the government source of financial assistance obtained by a majority of all students in Ontario's post-secondary institutions.
5. The SCHOLARSHIP sections (pages 12-39 and 54-55) contains a description of each award according to amount, eligibility criteria, application procedures and application deadlines.
6. The BURSARY sections (pages 41-52 and 57-60) provides information about awards that are based primarily on a student's financial need rather than academic achievement. These bursaries usually support attendance at both college and university and are also organized according to amount, eligibility criteria, application procedure and deadlines.

Please Note: Both bursaries and scholarships may require the completion of the local LKDSB application form. Both forms are available online at www.lkdsb.net. Enter Program/Curriculum and follow instructions on the screen.

NOTE:

Students and their parents should not consider information contained in this publication as being a complete listing of all scholarships and bursaries. It is intended as a guide to facilitate your personal search, and secondary school counsellors sincerely hope that it will be a useful component of your overall efforts to finance the post-secondary education to which you aspire.

Ontario Student Assistance Program (OSAP)

1. Applying online is free and faster. Internet address: <http://osap.gov.on.ca>
2. Paper OSAP application forms are available to download.
3. OSAP is based on the assumption that post-secondary education is the responsibility of you and your parents. OSAP loans assist you in meeting your education responsibilities, if there is "financial need". It is not meant to be a full-support program, and is administered through the chartered banks.
4. In simplistic terms, "Financial Need" is determined by:

ANNUAL SCHOOL COSTS	\$X	Government knows these costs
RESOURCES: (Yours & Your Family) -	\$Y	<i>(determined by information provided on OSAP application)</i>

YOUR NEED (Award)	= \$Z	<i>(is, therefore, determined by subtracting available resources from total costs)</i>
5. You begin to repay your OSAP LOAN after you graduate or withdraw from school. You may collect the first half of your loan following official registration at a post-secondary institution in the fall. The second half of the loan is received after registering officially for the second semester. (See the current OSAP application for guidelines on interest and repayment.)
