<p style="text-align: center;">Narrative Sept 28 – Nov 20</p>	<p>Modelled, Shared, Interactive, Guided, and Independent. <i>All students in the early stages of development should be encouraged to respond orally as well as using pictures, symbols and letters to represent their writing</i></p>	<p>- no diagnostic - no on-demand assessment</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Procedure Nov 23 – Dec 18</p>	<p>Modelled, Shared, Interactive, Guided, and Independent.</p>	<p>- no diagnostic - on-demand assessment</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Report Jan 4 – Feb 19</p>	<p>Modelled, Shared, Interactive, Guided, and Independent</p>	<p>- no diagnostic - no on-demand assessment</p>
