Principal's Report:

Pupil Accomodation Report

- Mrs. Wilson briefly touched on the 167 page report
- The Pupil Accommodation Report is posted on the LKDSB website (www.lkdsb.net). Mrs. Wilson encourages all to read the report, as it contains a significant amount of data and information to support the recommendations that are being made. The report suggests an 8 phase restructuring and rebuilding of LKDSB, which includes the closing of schools, relocation of students and staff and the building of new schools. These changes are necessary due to the drastic decline in enrollment, ministry changes in the funding model and the age of many of our LKDSB schools. The ministry is also giving a School Consolidation Capital incentive and a financial incentive for K to Grade 12 school reconfigurations.

Progress Reports – Due to labour action our Progress Reports that were originally to go home on November 13th will now be going home with students in Grades 1 to 8 on December 11th. Progress Reports will not be going home with Kindergarten, as Kindergarten does not have a ministry generated report card.

Collective Agreements – we now have ratified collective agreements with our elementary teachers, both centrally and locally and are back to business as usual. There are many plans in the works for professional development and continuing our work with math. The agreement covers the period September 2014 to August 31, 2017.

Additional Programs:

Mad Science – This after school program has been very well received. We had 58 students participate in the program. They had to rent 3 rooms in order to accommodate all the kids. The kids have been very engaged and excited in the program.

LCCVI Music Department – performed a concert for our staff and student body. Our Grade 6, 7 and 8 are going to Victoria Playhouse on December 16th for a Christmas Music Concert put on by LCCVI.
