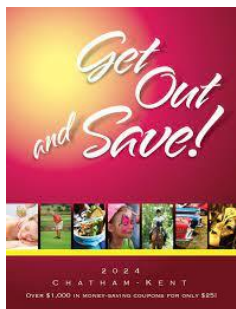


Can/Toy/Cleaning Products Drive
