Our Knight's volleyball teams are in action with games and practices for both our girls' and boys' teams.

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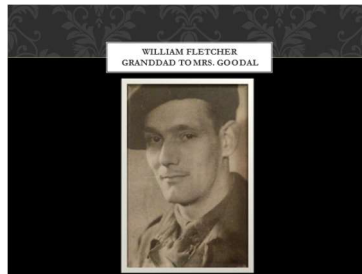
## Interview Info
