Accurate records are an important part of effective communication between school and the home. **Over the summer we will be updating information for all of the students of the Lambton Kent District School Board into Trillium, the new student information system for the Board.**

In this package you will find a registration form that will allow you to confirm or revise information for each child attending school. Over the summer we will be updating student records with information you have provided.

The revised form includes an opportunity for families of Aboriginal heritage to voluntarily self-identify students as First Nations, Métis or Inuit. The First Nations category includes Status and Non Status as well as families living both on and off reserve. As with all personal data collected, self-identification information is confidential and will be used only to support student learning. All families are encouraged to read the enclosed pamphlet explaining the Board's Policy on Voluntary Aboriginal Self-Identification.

Please complete the new registration form for each of your children and return in the stamped envelope provided. Your accurate and timely response will be appreciated and will provide for updated information to be on file for the new school year.
