SIR JOHN MOORE COMMUNITY SCHOOL RECIPIENT OF THE FUTURE SHOP TECH LAB GRANT

Sir John Moore Community School in Corunna is the recipient of a technology grant worth \$2,700 thanks to The Future Shop's Tech Lab Grant Program. Out of nearly three hundred applications, Sir John Moore was one of twelve elementary schools selected to receive funding to expand their existing initiatives. The funds will be used by the school's Lego Robotics Club.

Future Shop Tech Lab grants provide financial support for schools looking to improve technology in classrooms to help foster and advance learning. This year was the second time that Tech Lab grants were offered to elementary schools and the first year that dedicated grants were made available for schools looking to enhance technology in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) programs. Future Shop Tech Lab grants are one of the programs offered to support students and education under the Best Buy Canada community investment pillar.

At Sir John Moore Community School, STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) initiatives start with the LEGO Robotics Club and are integrated into classrooms.
