Re: Adult Crossing Guard Service

The Municipality of Chatham-Kent has informed the Lambton Kent District School Board (LKDSB) of the termination of the Adult Crossing Guard Services effective November 30, 2016. Chatham-Kent Council decided during its 2016 budget deliberations to end the crossing guard service, due to ongoing recruitment challenges and program sustainability concerns. Neither the LKDSB, nor the Municipality, are legislated to provide an adult crossing guard program.

The Municipality is currently in the process of installing pedestrian crossover devices at several sites where the adult crossing guard program is in place. However, not all of these locations will be replaced with a pedestrian crossover device, which is a decision based on the results of a traffic study conducted earlier this year. Additionally, the pedestrian crossover devices will not be in place prior to the end of the adult crossing guard service. All pedestrian crossover devices are expected to be installed by June 2017.

Pedestrian crossover devices will be installed at the following LKDSB school area locations:

- Blenheim Talbot Street West at Little Street
- Chatham Baldoon Road at Oxley Drive; Lacroix Street at Alexandra Avenue
- Dresden North Street at Dresden Area Central School
- Wheatley Erie Street North at Richard Street
- Wallaceburg Murray Street and Reaume Avenue (All-way Stop to be removed and School Crossing converted to a pedestrian crossover)
- Tilbury Stewart Street at Mable Street
