Lambton Kent District School Board is co-hosting an "Experience the Trades" event on November 16-17 at the Chatham-Kent John D. Bradley Convention Centre, along with four other local school boards and the Municipality of Chatham-Kent, to showcase careers in apprenticeable trades.

The Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program Coordinators from the five school boards are co-hosting the event. Featured guest speakers include: Yvonne Pilon, President and CEO, WEtech Alliance; Eric Janssen, Chief Revenue Officer, Intellitix; and Nour Hachem, Project Manager, St. Clair College.

Participating schools from the Lambton Kent District School Board will be attending during the school days to learn about careers in four sectors: motive power, service, industrial and construction. Parents and students in Grades 7-12 are invited to attend a special evening session on Wednesday, November 16 from 5:30 p.m. - 8 p.m.
