

Applying to University?

If you have been or are currently enrolled at the LKDSB alternative and continuing education school, then indicate so in the education section of your application. The name of the school is

Lambton Kent Alternative and Continuing Ed

Students who are currently enrolled at the LKDSB alternative and continuing education school and were born in 2003 or later ought not to request a transcript using eTMS in their OUAC application.

- Indicate that you are a current Ontario high school student.
- Be sure that the “To Date” for your Ontario high school is between September 2023 and August 2024. This is when you will finish Grade 12 or, in the case you are a graduate, when you will finish your current courses. If the “To Date” is outside of this range then you will not be recognized as a current Ontario high school student.
- For the question "Will you achieve your Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) by the end of the current school year, or have you already achieved it?", which is found in the Tell Us More section on the Education page, select "Yes". You will then be prompted to add your OEN (Ontario Education Number). If you answer “No”, then you not be recognized as a current Ontario high school student.

Students who are not currently enrolled at the LKDSB alternative and continuing education school or were born in 2002 or earlier will need to request a transcript using eTMS in their OUAC application. A transcript will be sent by the LKDSB records department.
