

## **Secondary Summer Learning Program August 31, 2022**

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The summer learning programs listed are ones that ran on continuing education enrolment registers and do not include adult education programs.

1019 students completed the program and were supported by 63 staff members. This does not include the social workers or graduation coaches who also supported students over the summer.

By comparison, a total of 1022 students completed the program in the summer of 2020.

### **Full Course eLearning**

- 37 courses, July 4 to 29, grade 8-12
- 737 students completed (361 LKDSB, 376 Out of Board)
- 76% completion rate (77% LKDSB, 74% Out of Board)
- 86% success rate of students who completed
- 21 grade 8 students reached ahead (13 LKDSB, 8 Out of Board)
- 140 LKDSB students took out of board summer eLearning courses in July or August that are not offered by the LKDSB summer learning program (e.g. French Immersion)
- Staffing: 31 full course and course upgrade eLearning teachers, 1 credit recovery eLearning teacher, 4 resource teachers, 2 EAs, 2 summer students, 2 program leaders, 1 Summer District eLearning Coordinator, 2 clerical staff

### **Course Upgrade eLearning**

- 4 courses, July 4 to 29, grade 9-12 LKDSB
- 3 students completed, 50% completion rate, 67% success rate of students who completed

### **Credit Recovery eLearning**

- 14 courses, July 4 to 29, grade 9-12 LKDSB
- 48 students completed, 72% completion rate, 63% success rate of students who completed
- Staffing: 1 credit recovery teacher

### **Dual Credits**

- 5 virtual courses (2 Lambton College, 3 St. Clair College), July 4 to 15, grade 11-12 and adult learners
- 12 students completed, 75% completion rate, 83% success rate of students who completed
- Staffing: 1 dual credit support teacher

### **Summer Co-op**

- July 4-August 12, grade 11-12
- 142 students completed, 85% completion rate, 96% success rate of students who completed
- Staffing: 11 summer co-op teachers, 1 summer co-op coordinator

### **Specialized Summer School Program**

- In-person special education classes: ECPP, IS, T2, July 4-29, Grade 9-12
- 11 students, 103 lessons completed (1 credit = 20 lessons)
- Staffing: 1 teacher

### **NLSS FNMI Integrated Arts Program**

- NAC101: land-based education and grade eight to nine transition focus
- In-person, NLSS, July 4-29, Grade 8-9, 100% self-identified Indigenous students
- 10 students completed (9 grade 8, 1 grade 9), 100% success rate
- Staffing: 1 teacher

### **WDSS FNMI Integrated Arts Program**

- NAC101: land-based education and grade eight to nine transition focus
- In-person, WDSS, July 4-29, Grade 8-9, 100% self-identified Indigenous students
- 21 students completed (19 grade 8, 2 grade 9), 90% success rate
- Staffing: 1 teacher

### **Walpole Island Summer School Program**

- In-person, credit recovery, Bkejwanong, July 4-29, Grade 9-12
- 26 students participated, 22 students recovered at least one course
- 29 courses recovered for a total of 26.5 credits
- Staffing: 2 teachers

### **International Language Program**

- 12 classes (14 Arabic, 1 Mandarin, 1 Turkish, 1 Urdu), 11 in-person and 1 virtual
- July 4-August 12, JK-grade 8
- 88 students participated (57 Arabic, 20 Mandarin, 5 Turkish, 6 Urdu)
- Staffing: 12 instructors

The Summer Learning Program continues to provide a valuable experience for students in the LKDSB. Students were able to utilize summer learning to

- Earn the last credit for the Ontario Secondary School Diploma
- Complete the co-op requirements for the Specialist High Skills Major
- Meet post-secondary program pre-requisites
- Reach ahead in taking credit courses
- Upgrade, recover, or repeat courses
- Reinforce and consolidate learning from the previous school year

The LKDSB has a positive reputation for its eLearning courses as evidenced by the large number of out of board students that enroll. Unique features include

- Daily synchronous virtual support given to students.
- Resource teacher and EA support.
- Attendance follow-up with students and parents.
