Summer Semester General Information

Please contact your students secondary school Guidance Department to discuss summer school offerings.

Students are expected to log in every day, to hand in work by the assigned due date.

Final exams will be on July 29, 2019. Exams are written online, but students can choose to write their exams at either AMSS or JMSS.

There will be no opportunity to submit course work beyond this date.

REGISTRATION PROCESS

The registration deadline is June 28, 2019

Students are only able to register in one Summer Semester course or program including Summer Semester eLearning, Summer Co-op and Summer semester continuing education courses.

Only the guidance department from the student's home school can register a student in a summer semester program or course.

The secondary summer semester program is open to secondary students in the summer following their grade 9 year.

Grade 9 students are eligible to take grade 9 courses and are also eligible to take grade 10 Civics and Careers.



STARTING A COURSE

Students will receive an email to the address used during summer semester registration with important course information. If you have not received an email by July 2, 2019 please contact one of our summer semester offices.

Students from other Boards will access their course with Lambton Kent through their own Board's eLearning site via the My Courses in Other Board's widget.

DROP A COURSE

Deadline to drop a course is July 15, 2019

To officially drop a course so a mark will not show on a transcript parents of students who are under the age of 18 and students who are 18 years of age or older **must contact the Site Principal of the secondary summer semester program directly by calling between the hours of Monday—Friday 8:30am—12:30pm.**

A phone messages and informing the semester teacher within the eLearning classroom will **NOT** result in a course being dropped.
