Re: LKDSB Pupil Accommodations Report 2016/2017

As noted in the attached report prepared by the Town's Planner, your report titled "LKDSB Pupil Accommodations Report 2016/2017", projects Errol Village Public School enrolment to decline over the next 10 years. Town of Plympton-Wyoming Council is concerned that, given the Board's projections, it is conceivable that Errol Village Public School's future might be in doubt.

The School Board's October 4th, 2016 report supports directing all students from Aberarder Central, Bosanquet Central, Kinnwood Central and North Lambton Secondary to a new school in Forest. Plympton-Wyoming Council is concerned that the report makes no reference to Errol Village Public School and its future. Council is also concerned that the reports fails to examine whether it might make more sense to direct children from Camlachie and from a portion of Aberarder Central School's current boundary to Errol Village Public School. From a practical viewpoint, Errol Village is much closer to these areas of Plympton-Wyoming than Forest is. For example, Errol Village Public School is approximately two (2) kilometres from the centre of Camlachie, whereas Camlachie is approximately 20 kilometres from the proposed school in Forest.

The Town of Plympton-Wyoming Council would appreciate Lambton Kent District School Board's reconsideration of its boundaries for the new school in Forest and for Errol Village Public School. At a minimum, Council would like the Board to explain the rationale for sending elementary school students from Camlachie to the proposed school in Forest.
