(did not get a volunteer from HWB to get me an inventory)

-some as old as 1954; not up to date: 4 plaques AAW – 1954 - 2004
 6 plaques DAG - 1974 - 2006
 6 plaques HWB-

-spoke with the curator at the Museum and they would consider taking some stuff if they knew what we had in mind
- My thoughts, and it was agreed upon by those present, are that the kids in the 7/8 wing really don't care about the old plaques and banners. If wall space is available in their wing it should be for the current students to display their achievements and the "now" of their school years. They don't care about who won what in 1964 at DA or HW, that belongs to the students of that generation. So perhaps the place for the "history and memories" is in the museum
- I propose that for the plaques, a digital photo record be created and keep at the museum and perhaps at each school - the same could be done for the banners once they are removed from the gym
-a suggestion was made that the banners of DAG could be offered for a Charity auction so the banners would find a home with a person who truly cares about their preservation
-yearbooks/photos/slide shows for the graduates could likewise be digitally preserved with the hard copies stored at a common site yet to be determined
-I suggest that it should be considered that the plaques that are already at WDSS for Laing be removed and all the grade 7/8 awards be photographed and then stored together.

For DA: Some current DA stuff (photos, gators, Art work) should go with the kids to their "new school" – the kids could choose what should go.

The "Sue Talach" award at DAG has a board that decides how funds are allocated – they will decide what to do next.

For HWB: Donated awards such as the "Lightfoot" award should be discussed with the school of origin and the benefactor to see if they would like it to continue as a gr. 8 award and move to WDSS or stay at the home school as a gr. 6 award
