At the most recent Board Meeting, Trustee Northmore asked for a motion to write a letter to the		

to discuss the decreased funding and there is a Strategic Priorities consultation meeting Friday morning. Trustee Northmore asked the Administrators present at this meeting to forward any ideas that would help target Indigenous Education to her before noon on Friday. Indigenous Lead Dallas Sinopole - Indigenous Lead Dallas reported that the building of The Learning Lodge commenced today including seven students and three staff members from both the LKDSB and the SCCDSB that are from the community and noted that it will take three days in total to build the frame. Dallas also reported that there is an upcoming cance build which is open to students in all secondary grades. Dallas noted that there needs to be a deeper conversation as to how to help Indigenous students achieve success and the importance of needing to engage parents further. Dallas asked if administrators have any ideas to please bring them forward.
