BACK TO SCHOOL CHECKLIST

- Review the LKDSB's *Reopening Our Schools* plan
- Check the school year start dates for your child
- Complete the Daily Screening Questionnaire for Parents/Guardians/Students Before Attending School
- Share school arrival information with emergency contacts
- Practice wearing a mask. Note: Masks are mandatory for students in Grades 4-12
- Practice proper hand hygiene and respiratory etiquette
- Review student transportation guidelines
- Label your child's clothing and personal belongings
- Bring a refillable water bottle (contact the school if your child does not have a water bottle)
- Bring a lunch
- Bring your own device (either personal or LKDSB IT device, if applicable)
- Bring only necessary items to school to limit the amount of personal belongings
