What a great way to teach our students about helping others while raising funds for our school. These adorable calendars practically sell themselves.



Lions Foundation of Canada Dog Guides empowers Canadians living with disabilities to navigate their world with confidence and independence, by providing a Dog Guide at no cost and supporting them in their journey together. Located in Oakville, Ontario with a breeding and training facility in Breslau (between Kitchener and Guelph), we are the only school to train Dog Guides in seven distinct programs. From breeding to rearing and training with a lifetime of follow-up services, each Dog Guide is \$35,000 to train and place. The Foundation relies on donations to provide these special matches and does not receive any government funding.

LFC Dog Guides has seven programs: Canine Vision, Hearing, Seizure Response, Diabetic Alert, Service, Autism Assistance and Facility Support
