3. Language Curriculum
  - The school will join a virtual presentation about the newly revised Language curriculum (2023) hosted by the LKDSB System Coordinator – Student Achievement Elementary.
4. Grade Specific Sessions:
  - a. Kindergarten – Grade 2 Educators: Phonics Resource Introduction – Flyleaf
    - The Kindergarten – Grade 2 Educators will join a virtual presentation introducing a new phonics resource, Flyleaf, that supports teaching the newly revised Language curriculum (2023). This session is hosted by the LKDSB System Coordinator – Student Achievement Elementary and some Early Literacy Intervention Coaches.
  - b. French Immersion Kindergarten – Grade 2 Educators: French Phonics Resource Introduction – Pratique Phonemique
    - The French Immersion Kindergarten – Grade 2 Educators will join a virtual presentation introducing a new French phonics resource, Pratique Phonemique, that aligns with the newly revised Language curriculum (2023). The LKDSB Language Consultant hosts this session.

- c. Grade 3 – 5 Educators: Board Math Action Plans – Number Talks & Diagnostic Work using Lawson Continua
    - The Grade 3 – 5 Educators will join a virtual presentation to implement the Math Action Plan by applying the Lawson Continua with students and teacher modelling using number talks or ‘think alouds’. This session is hosted by the LKDSB System Coordinator – Math Achievement and some Math Facilitators.
  
  - d. Grade 6 – 8 Educators: Board Math Action Plans – Number Talks & Diagnostic Work using Fraction Continuum
    - The Grade 6 – 8 Educators will join a virtual presentation to implement the Math Action Plan by applying the Fraction Continua with students and teacher modelling using number talks or ‘think alouds’. This session is hosted by the LKDSB System Coordinator – Math Achievement and some Math Facilitators.
