## Safe Arrival and Dismissal

Our school day begins with an entrance bell at 9:20 am. Yard supervision begins at 9:05 am. Any student who arrives after 9:20 am will be considered late and be required to obtain a late slip from the office. Being present and punctual each day is critical in a successful school year. Following the routine of entering with their classmates and having a regular routine assists students with developing their own strong work habits.

Our day ends with a dismissal bell at 3:40 pm. Buses will pick the students up at the Harold Street entrance. All students who are picked up by parents, at the end of the school day, are to be picked up at the Harold Street entrance. Should there be a need to arrange an earlier pickup time, please send a note with your student to be given to his/her/their teacher or call the office and ask that the message be given to the teacher. All students leaving early are expected to notify the office when they are leaving, exit, and be picked up at the main entrance on Cecil Street.

If your child is absent from school, we would appreciate a phone call with the child's name, their homeroom teacher, and the reason for their absence. Absences can also be reported online through School Messenger. If this information is not received by the school, a Safe Schools call will be made to determine the reason for the absence and to ensure that the parent is aware of the student's absence. According to Board attendance regulations, no call and the office cannot reach a parent about the reason for the absence, the child's absence is recorded as truant.

## **Forms**

There will be numerous forms coming home this week. Completing these forms accurately and returning them promptly to the school is essential. Below is a list of the forms you should have received.

#### Student Verification Form

This provides an opportunity to confirm or change personal information including addresses, phone numbers, and contact information. Should this information change at another point in the school year, please contact the school to update this information. The CASL portion on this form gives permission for the Lambton Kent District School Board to send electronic messages to the email address you provide.

#### • Media Release Form

This form gives permission for your child's photo to be used in the local newspaper, school newsletter, the yearbook, and the school website.

## Acceptable Use of Technology Policy

When filled out and returned, students will be allowed to use LKDSB Technology and Wi-Fi. Please, with your student, read this information carefully going over all the rules and responsibilities. Students will not be permitted to use technology until the signed policy is returned.

## Permission to Leave School Property Form

During the first nutrition break, 11:20am – 12:00pm, Grade 7 and 8 students have the opportunity to leave school property, go home or go uptown, for lunch. For your student to leave school property, this form must be signed and returned.

## Permission to Participate in Walking Excursion Permission Form

Throughout the school year, our students participate in walking excursions in our community to genuinely enrich the classroom experience and reinforce curriculum expectations. To allow flexibility for students to participate in these valuable community activities, this permission form will allow for walking trips during the 2023-2024 school year.

#### Student Accident Insurance

Please note that the Lambton Kent District School Board does not provide accident insurance coverage for student injuries that occur on school property or during school activities including extracurricular sports. If a student is injured, parent(s)/guardian(s) are responsible for any costs not covered by the Ontario Health Insurance Plan (OHIP) or their employer's health care plan. To help protect your family, consider obtaining student accident insurance which provides coverage against accident expenses including emergency dental care, ambulance transport, casts, crutches, physiotherapy, and more. As a convenience to you, the Lambton Kent District School Board has arranged to offer student accident insurance through insuremykids. Whether your child is involved in an accident at school or during non-school hours, insuremykids® can help protect you financially. #### **Inclement Weather**

Ridgetown District High School is in Zone 6 and Zone 7. Please listen to local radio stations, visit www.schoolbusinfo.com, or download the My SBI Mobile App to receive updates on bus delays or cancellations due to inclement weather. Buses that have been canceled in the morning due to inclement weather will not run in the afternoon. If parents drive students to school in the morning, they are responsible for picking their children up and taking them home in the afternoon. Buses that have been canceled in the morning due to fog will operate in the afternoon. Please remember to call the school if your child will be absent due to bus cancellations.
