 - Awarded to students with 480 marks or more in best 6 Grade 12 courses
 - All courses and streams are eligible for consideration
2. **BEST SCHOLAR AWARD**
 - Plaque presented by Student Council
 - Awarded to the student with the highest average in each grade
3. **EXCELLENCE IN EDUCATION AWARD OF RECOGNITION**
 - Pin, certificate and plaque
 - Awarded for demonstration of personal best and school/community citizenship
 - Selected by O.S.S.T.F.
4. **GOVERNOR GENERAL'S ACADEMIC MEDAL**
 - Bronze medal
 - Awarded to the student who achieves highest average of **all** Grade 11 & 12 courses upon graduation
 - All courses and streams are eligible for consideration
5. **HIGHEST MARKS – MEDALS & CERTIFICATES**
 - Medal and certificate
 - Awarded to students who have achieved highest marks in one or more subject(s)
6. **ONTARIO PRINCIPALS' COUNCIL AWARD FOR STUDENT LEADERSHIP**
 - Plaque
 - Selected by the Principal

 - Selected by the Arts Department
8. **ROTARY STRIVE AWARDS *** 4 x \$300
- For students studying **ENGLISH** at the college or workplace level throughout Grades 11 and 12
 - Attendance, punctuality, citizenship, effort, and teamwork will be considered
 - Selected by the Principal and Student Services Curriculum Leader

- For a graduating student
 - Pursuing post-secondary studies in the field of Health or Physical Education
 - Awarded for being an outstanding **HEALTH & PHYSICAL EDUCATION** student
 - Selected by the Physical Education Department
10. **LOUIS LAWRENCE ODETTE JR. SCHOLARSHIP *** \$2,000
- For a graduating student
 - Enrolling in the **BACHELOR OF COMMERCE** Program; to attend the Odette School of Business (U. of Windsor)
 - Confirmation of enrolment will need to be made prior to receiving scholarship
 - Selected by the donor and Student Services
11. **JIM ROWSOM AGRICULTURAL BURSARY** \$200
- For a graduating student
 - Pursuing post-secondary education in **AGRICULTURE**
 - Presented at the Comber Fair
 - Inform Student Services if you qualify
12. **CHARTWELLS BURSARY SCHOOL DINING AWARD **** \$250
- For a graduating student
 - Pursuing post-secondary education or apprenticeship preferably in a **FOOD SERVICE** career
 - Selected by the School Committee and Principal

- For a student who is completing their high school education
 - Pursuing post-secondary education, entering a **BUSINESS** or **TRADE**

Criteria for Groups A & B

Qualifying students must:

- 1) be registered as a full-time student in their final two semesters at a secondary school under the jurisdiction of the (former) Kent County Board of Education; and
- 2) attend a College or University in the semester immediately following the end of the school year in which they complete secondary school.

Students will be included in one of the following two groups:

Group A

Scholarships will be based on an average of the top six Grade 12 University (4U) and/or Grade 12 University/College (4M) destination courses. Co-operative Education courses will not be used to calculate this average.

- 1) Completion of a minimum of six Grade 12 University (4U) and/or Grade 12 University/College (4M) courses;
Note: These courses do not need to be taken in the same year.
and
- 2) At least two of these six courses are categorized as Grade 12 University (U) destination.

Group B

Students who do not meet the criteria outlined for Group A will be considered for Group B.

- 1) An average will be calculated from the top six senior (Grade 11 or 12) courses. **Note:** These courses do not need to be taken in the same year.
- 2) A maximum of one two-credit Co-operative Education course may be calculated into the average.

Awards will be granted in each of the groups as follows:

Highest average	\$1400
Second highest average	\$1200
Third highest average	\$1000
