Morning Routine for 9:00-9:15 a.m.

Kindergarten to Gr. 2 students should be **dropped off at the gate**, not earlier than 9:00 a.m. when supervision begins. Please note, as per LKDSB's Safe Schools Policy, **only students and staff** are permitted on school grounds during school hours. If you have made arrangements for a grandparent, friend, alternate guardian, etc. to drop your child off, please ensure they are aware of this policy.

Grade 3 to 8 students and all bus students will enter the yard and move to their appropriate playground area.

Students who arrive after 9:15 a.m. must enter through the front doors and obtain a late slip prior to proceeding to class.

Student Absences & Automated Safe Arrival Calls

Zone School's automated attendance messaging system notifies parents/guardians when your child has been marked absent and the school has not been notified of the reason for the absence. To follow-up, we will contact the parent/guardian phone numbers and email addresses that we have on file and ask that you call the school to confirm the absence and provide the reason. You can help by ensuring that the school has your most updated contact information and by notifying the school office in advance if your child will be late or absent.

Please note: To avoid calls and emails regarding attendance, kindly contact the school in advance to let us know your child will be absent. School voicemail messages are checked regularly.

Daily COVID-19 Screening Tool

Thank you for assessing your child(ren) daily and reporting whether they are experiencing any signs of illness. Please refer to the Ontario screening tool <https://covid-19.ontario.ca/school-screening/>. The screening tool will advise you whether you should send your child(ren) to school or not and will also advise you of next steps. All students who are experiencing symptoms consistent with COVID-19 must follow the directions of the screener.

Medication

If your child needs prescription medication administered during school hours, please see the office for an "Authorization for the Administration of Oral Medication" form. It must be completed by the parent/guardian and physician and forwarded to the Principal for each school year. Over-the-counter medications (e.g., Tylenol, Advil) **will not** be administered by staff and should not be sent to school.

Zone Township Central School is in **Zone 6**. Listen to the radio for bus delays and cancellations or check <http://www.schoolbusinfo.com> for regular updates. If buses are cancelled in the morning due to fog, they **will** run in the afternoon. If buses are cancelled in the morning due to snow and icy road conditions, they **will not** run in the afternoon and parents and guardians must make arrangements for picking up students at the end of the day.

Allergy Alert

Please be advised that Zone School is a Nut Aware school. We ask that the following products not be sent to school:

- Peanuts and all nuts
- Foods containing nuts
- Soya peanut butter, WOW Butter, etc.
- Shellfish
- Scented products (cologne, perfume, etc.)

Milk Program

Starting immediately, chocolate milk will be available for students to purchase. Milk cards must be purchased through School Cash On-Line.

Parent Council/School Advisory Council

Parent Council/School Advisory Council is made up of a group of parents, teachers, and a community representative who meet during the school year for the purpose of providing positive input to the principal on school-related educational issues. Council meetings are open to all members of the school community. This year the first meeting will be held virtually on **Thursday, September 28th at 4:00 p.m.** Subsection 4 (4) of O. Violence Threat Risk Assessment Protocol

The Lambton Kent District School Board is committed to providing safe learning environments for all students, staff, school visitors, and community members. When a student behaves inappropriately, principals will most often employ progressive discipline strategies to help a student take responsibility for their actions, learn from their mistakes, and make better choices in the future.

In more extreme cases however, when a student's behaviour poses a potential threat to their own or others' well-being, the Community Violence Threat Risk Assessment Protocol (VTRA) supports principals in taking further steps to safeguard everyone.

The VTRA protocol outlines how a school responds immediately to threatening incidents including but not limited to: possession of a weapon or replica weapon, bomb threat or plan, verbal or written (including electronic) threats to harm oneself or others, other threats of violence, and fire setting.

The initial response team is likely to include the Principal/Vice-Principal, police, and board staff. Should conditions warrant, a Community Threat Assessment Team will be convened. This community team includes representatives of community agencies who work with schools and boards to keep our students and staff safe, such as local police and children's mental health organizations. Parents and guardians will be notified if their child will be discussed through the Community Violence Threat Risk Assessment Protocol.

If parents/guardians cannot be reached, or if they choose not to provide consent, but a concern for safety still exists due to threatening behaviour, the threat assessment may still proceed.
