**TERM ONE REPORT CARDS**

Term one report cards go home with students in FDK to Grade 8 on Friday, February 18, 2022. Teachers write comments on the report card that focus on what students have learned in the curriculum and how they are progressing in their learning skills. The comments describe strengths and identify the next steps for improvement. Comments on the first page of the report card directly relate to learning skills. These six work habits are extremely important and help the child access the curriculum and succeed in their learning. You will notice that the Ministry of Education has changed the mathematics mark to reflect one average mark across all the strands. Parents are asked to complete and sign Page 4 of their child(ren)'s report card and return it to school.
