REPORT CARDS

Report Cards and FDK Communication of Learning documents will be ready to be sent home on **Friday**, **February 16th**.

The first page of the report card focuses on six learning skills that contribute to helping your child succeed in the learning environment. Responsibility, initiative, independent work, collaboration, self-regulation, and organization are all reinforced at school in the class and school community through explicit teaching, school-wide activities, routines, opportunities, and accommodations we offer to help students achieve success every day. Any extra reinforcement of these skills outside of school has the potential for your student to make tremendous gains in the learning environment.

Teachers will provide feedback on learning from Term 1 by reporting on student progress towards curriculum subject benchmarks while giving guidance and next steps on further cultivating more success in several areas. We recognize that each of our students has unique strengths, starting points and challenges in the learning environment. The staff have done a remarkable job getting to know each of their students, developing plans, and seeking support to ensure rich learning tasks are consistently a part of the classroom environment.


We spend a minimum of 40 minutes a day outside so ensure your Badger is dressed for cold temperatures. With proper footwear helps to them engage in fun!
