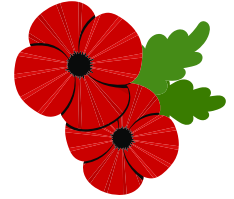

LKDSB Cell Phone Policy

The Ontario Government has updated the school Code of Conduct to restrict the use of personal mobile devices at school. The use of personal mobile devices is only permitted during instructional time for educational purposes, as directed by the educator in the classroom, for health and medical purposes and/or to support special educational needs. All devices will be away until the teacher invites students to use their devices, when appropriate for learning purposes. Devices may be off and away in the student's cubby, school bag, cell phone holder in the classroom, or on a counter or other location decided by the teacher. If there is a reason that the student would like to use the device, they should discuss with the teacher the appropriate time to do so.

If there is a medical purpose for the device, please contact the office. The school is not responsible for loss, theft or breakage of any device brought to school. We have lots of school provided devices at this time. As a result, cell phones do not serve any educational purpose. I strongly recommend that cell phones remain at home. If a student is using a cell phone, the student will be asked to put the phone away. On the second offense, the phone will be brought to the office. It will be returned at the end of the school day. In the event of a third offence or more a parent or guardian will be responsible for picking up the device.
