

## FREE Grade 7 Vaccines!

Attention all parents/guardians of students in Grade 7/8! You won't always be able to protect your children, but you can make sure their immunizations are up to date. Protect your child from three preventable diseases - hepatitis B, HPV and meningococcal disease.

**Due to COVID-19, students who normally get their shots at school will need to book an appointment at a community clinic.** All grade 7 students and grade 8 students who missed their second dose of hepatitis B and/or HPV last year are eligible to attend these clinics.

Our first clinics will be held between December 7th and December 18th. Additional clinics will be added in 2021.
