

School Advisory Council: Our School Advisory Council is made up of a group of parents, teachers, and a community representative who meet during the school year for the purpose of providing positive input to the principal on school-related educational issues. Breakfast Program: Our Breakfast Program will be starting on Monday, September 11. Students are welcome to join us for a nutritious breakfast at 8:40 in the Professional Learning Room. If you granted your student permission to participate in the Breakfast Program last year, they will be able to access this program right away. If your student is going to attend for the first time this year, the office will be calling parents/guardians for verbal approval. We would like to thank all our volunteers for their dedication to the Breakfast Program and to our school community ... we appreciate you!

Allergy Alert: Please be advised that Colonel Cameron is a Nut Aware school. We have students and staff with life-threatening allergies to certain foods and scents. We ask that the following products not be sent to school:

- Peanuts and all nuts
- Foods containing nuts
- Soya peanut butter, WOW Butter, etc.
- Shellfish
- Scented products (cologne, perfume, etc.)

Prevalent Medical forms were sent home with report cards in June. Please return those to the school by the end of the month. If you need one, please let us know and if your child has out-grown their condition, please also let us know that.

Medication: If your child needs prescription medication administered during school hours, please contact the office for an "Authorization for the Administration of Oral Medication" form. It must be completed by the parent/guardian and physician and forwarded to the Principal for each school year. Over-the-counter medications (e.g., Tylenol, Advil) will not be administered by staff and should not be sent to school.



Student Absences: Regular school attendance is extremely important to the success of all students. As difficult as it can be some days, starting the school day on time is important. Our Safe School Policy requires that parents or quardians notify the school through the School Messenger App if students will be absent or late. Please see the attached School Messenger documentation to register for this convenient App. It is essential for safety reasons that we are aware if your child is not at school. If we have not heard from you, School Messenger will send an automated phone call and email to parents/guardians. Please help us by contacting the school before our morning or afternoon bells ring to report absenteeism. Should you need to pick up your student before the end of the day, please notify the school office before 2:00 pm. Late students need to report to the office before going to class. We appreciate everyone's cooperation.

Pediculosis / Head Lice: During the course of the year, we will be checking students for head lice in an attempt to reduce the potential spreading within the school. We kindly ask that should you detect lice in your child's hair that you notify the office. We appreciate your support in working to reduce the instance of head lice. All incidents are kept confidential.

Inclement Weather: In the instance of inclement weather (fog at this stage of the year), buses may be cancelled for safety reasons. We kindly ask that on mornings where you may be uncertain to listen to local radio or check http://www.schoolbusinfo.com/ for inclement weather. Colonel Cameron is located in Bus Zone 3. Should there be a cancellation due to fog, buses will not run in the morning but will return the students home in the afternoon. Bus cancellation due to snow will not have the buses available all day. On these days, schools will remain open unless notified.
