This depends on the number of students enrolled at each grade level and the Ministry of Education’s class size restrictions. However, each year there is a possibility that sometimes changes must be made to comply with Ministry of Education regulations.

As a result of conversations with LKDSB, we are required to re-organize our classroom placements to meet its obligation to class size averages.

In consultation with the homeroom teacher, curriculum partners, learning resource teacher and myself, we have considered all the moves and will work with you to ensure a smooth transition for your child. **The families that have been affected, have already been contacted.** We will be starting our new class placements on Monday, September 20, 2021.
