Warm Weather

With the onset of summer-like weather, it is important that students come to school prepared for outdoor activities. In addition to light, comfortable warm-weather clothing appropriate for school, including hats to shade the ears, face, and neck, it is also important that students bring a water bottle and that they wear sunscreen.

The application of sunscreen is a life skill that children need to learn at an early age. Burns from over-exposure to sun are dangerous. Even on days that may appear overcast, UV rays, which are damaging to our skin, can be harmful.

It is important that, as parents/guardians, you teach your child(ren) how to apply sunscreen. Long-lasting formulas are best. If you help them apply a long-lasting sun block before they come to school, it would only be necessary for a reapplication towards mid-afternoon. Although it is not possible for staff to apply sunscreen to an entire class, we can help remind students to make sure they are covered, assist where needed, and re-enforce a sun safety message.

It should be as common for students to bring their sunscreen to school as it is for them to bring a water bottle. If we make it a habit to protect ourselves from dangerous exposure to sun, we will guard against possible serious illness in later life.
