It's Time to Play Catch-Up, With Routine Vaccines!

Each year, Grade 7 students receive three vaccinations as part of the school-based vaccine program to **protect against Hepatitis B, Meningitis, and Human Papillomavirus (HPV)**. Due to COVID-19, many students have missed these important vaccines.

Lambton Public Health is offering **catch-up immunization clinics** to all students in grades 7 to 12 (born between 2004 and 2009) who have not received a first or second dose of these vaccines. Catch-up vaccine clinics will be scheduled at our community clinic sites starting the week of March Break.

Can my primary care provider provide these vaccines?

Yes, your primary health care provider may be able to provide school-based vaccines (such as hepatitis B, HPV and Meningococcal ACYW-135). They are free as long as your child is eligible for a publicly funded dose. These vaccines will have to be ordered for your child, so please contact your physician or primary healthcare provider if you are interested in this option.

Already immunized? As a parent or guardian, **you are required to report your child's immunizations** to your local public health unit if your child attends school, or a licensed daycare centre.
