#### **HOT LUNCHES!**

#### Important Information from School Council:

Hot lunches are a means for students to have a different option for lunch once per month. They are ran by school council volunteers. All funds raised are used for various student needs. To make this go smoothly, please note the following practices:

- If students are absent on delivery day: If they have a sibling, the sibling will bring it home (class teacher to deliver it to the sibling) or parents can pick it up but need to notify us by 10am that they will pick it up. If neither of these are happening, then the food will be handed out to other students so it is not wasted.
- When food orders come in they need to be exact change as no change will be given. If there is change, school council will consider this a donation to their fundraising efforts.
