Throughout the school year, you are encouraged to contact us with any questions or concerns. For classroom related items, it is best to first contact the classroom teacher before reaching out to the office. The relationship between classroom teacher and home is an important one that benefits from open communication. For special education questions or concerns, you are still encouraged to connect with the classroom teacher as they are responsible for programming for the child in your care. Our resource teacher, Aron Armstrong, can also support with questions related to meeting your child's learning needs.

Allergies:

We want our school environment to be safe and healthy for all our students and staff. At this time we are asking for the school to be fragrance sensitive this year due to allergies. Please minimize the use of scented items (ex. Please do not send scented hand sanitizer). Thank you for your understanding.

Bus Information:

When logging into the parent portal and reviewing bus pick up and drop off times, please be sure to click on "contacts" and scroll down to look at the seat assignment for those in your family riding the bus. CLASS plans to continue with assigned seating this year.

You can also download an app for updates on cancellations and delays: www.mysbi.ca. If you have the old version you will need to remove the app and reinstall the new version for it to work.

Our bus zone is 2, however, we do have buses running in other zones. Please keep in mind that when buses are cancelled you will need to pick your child up at the end of the day.

If your child will not be riding the bus, please send a note or make a phone call that day in advance of dismissal time. For additional information on busing please see the student guide.

Please do not drive or park in the bus loading zone between 8:30am - 9:00am and 2:45pm - 3:30pm. Parents who need to walk students to the gate must park in the parking lot. Prevalent Medical Conditions and Medication

In the first few weeks of school, students with known medical conditions will be sent home forms that will need to be completed/reviewed. Please review all the details on the form, make edits, sign it and return it to the school so that our plans of care reflect up to date information. If you do not receive a package and your child does have a medical condition that needs our attention, please contact the office to request a form.

Before the school can administer medication to students we must have a medical physician complete the consent form. If your child requires medication to be administered at school, please bring the completed form and medication to the office. If you require a form please contact the office for a form.

School Messenger

At the Lambton Kent District School Board, one of our greatest priorities is ensuring students have arrived safely at school every day. You may have received notification about your child's absence from our School Messenger automated attendance messaging system. We have now added a School Messenger Parent/Guardian Reporting Tool for you to notify the school about your child's absence.

Parents/guardians can use School Messenger in one of the following three ways to report your child's absence:

- Option 1: Call a toll-free number (844-487-3695) and follow the prompts.
- Option 2: Set up a secure online School Messenger account and login to a website https://go.schoolmessenger.ca/#/home
- Option 3: Download and set up the School Messenger app (Apple or Android) to a smart phone or tablet.

Parents are also welcome to leave a message with the school regarding absences or respond to the messenger when it calls to report the absence

Arrival and Early Dismissal

There will be supervision staff on the yard for arrival at 8:40am. A friendly reminder that there will be no supervision before this time. Please contact the office or send a note to your child(ren)'s teacher if you will require an early dismissal. All early pickups are done at the main entrance to the school. Please ring the buzzer to request your child be dismissed to you.

School Council

We have a few members on council already and would love for you to join us! Our first meeting of the year will be on Tuesday, September 12th at 4:00pm. Nominations and an election will occur the first meeting. Anyone interested in learning more about our school and participating in decisions that help shape the future of Hanna is welcome to attend. Volunteers are an integral part of offering programs at our school. Please join! If you would be interested in volunteering occasionally, we could use your help! Visitors

There is controlled access to all doors in the school. There is a buzzer to the right of the main entrance doors. All visitors to the office are required to sign into the office and enter through our controlled entrance.

Areas for Our School to Improve:

A look at attendance over the past year indicates we can do better to support student learning. Students really should be attending every single day for many reasons. One reason is that consistency and structure helps the day to run smoothly for all students. When students attend irregularly, they can feel confused about the day to day expectations. When they arrive late, they miss out on learning and also disrupt lessons for others.

The second reason is that missing school, even once per month, impacts their learning. Students are taught new concepts daily. As well, concepts are reviewed and practiced daily. If they miss, then they don't get the chance to learn along with the rest of the class and their chances to reinforce key concepts with teacher support are missed. As a staff, we have discussed the importance of punctual and regular attendance. While we recognize that some circumstances cannot be helped, we are asking for your partnership to increase on time arrivals and attendance at Hanna.

Another focus for our school this year will be on assessment driven instruction. Teachers will be examining how they use assessments to plan for meeting individual and whole class learning needs. We want to ensure everyone receives learning that supports them to make academic gains. If your teacher suggests practice that is specifically for your child, it is because they've identified through assessments that your child would benefit. Your partnership to fulfill any of these requests is greatly appreciated as it will support your child to work towards their academic goals. Every little bit helps! Thank you for partnering with us to make the most of your child's education.
