Parents and guardians have the responsibility to report their child's vaccinations to the Chatham Kent Public Health Unit, as part of ensuring that all school aged children are up to date on their vaccinations. If this process is not completed, students' risk being suspended from attending school effective March 5<sup>th</sup>, 2024. To avoid this headache and give families plenty of time to report the vaccinations which have already taken place, or to schedule to receive the vaccinations in time, information is being shared with all parents and guardians now. #### Student Absences

If your child is going to be absent from school, please call the school at 519-676-5481. When you leave a message, include the first and last name of your child(ren), their teacher and the reason for the absence. Thank you in advance for your assistance with reporting any absences as this information helps our office staff immensely.

Parents can also use SCHOOL MESSENGER to report student absences efficiently. How to sign up and create a SchoolMessenger account:

1. Open an internet browser and search for https://go.schoolmessenger.ca/#/home or download the BLUE SchoolMessenger app.

2. Click Sign up in the upper right corner.

3. Use the email address on file at the school and create a password. Important note: You must use the same email address your school has on record. If you wish to use a different one, please contact your school and ask them to update your email address.

4. Click Sign up. Choose your password. Select Location as Canada. Tap Sign Up. You will receive a verification email. From this email, click the link to verify. This will open in a browser where you will be prompted to enter your login details. Log in and confirm your details.

#### Values, Influences and Peers

Grade 5 students from M. Durepos and Mrs. Brownlee, and Mrs. Stanford's classes will be participating with Special Constable Koldyk of the Chatham Kent Police to learn how to be a responsible citizen, demonstrate positive social behaviour and community values. The program is 6 weeks in length, with weekly lessons cotaught by Constable Koldyk and the classroom teacher. At the conclusion of the program, students have a celebratory time where they receive a diploma, a shirt and a cupcake to enjoy.

#### School Playground

Our school playground is now closed for the winter. The playground equipment becomes too dangerous during the fall and winter months with the accumulation of snow and ice, as well as with students wearing winter clothing such as scarves that can potentially get caught in the equipment.
