1. Principal's report:
  - We have set 4 goals this year:

### **Inclusive Diversity Goal- actions to champion anti-oppression education**

We will use student voice in our code of conduct to demonstrate our commitment to anti-oppression education.

### **Indigenous Education Goal- Truth and Reconciliation commitments**

We commit to building a stronger community relationship with our Indigenous neighbours.

### **Student Well-Being Goal- feelings of belonging, caring trusting adult and sense of welcoming**

We will focus on building perseverance in students as they identify and understand their emotions.

### **Student Achievement Goal- numeracy**

We will build numerical fluency through the implementation of Number Talks into their daily routine 3 times a week.

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- We are waiting to hear if our proposal is accepted to participate in a culturally responsive and relevant pedagogy inquiry project through the Ministry of Education, we are very excited for this opportunity.
  - We have revised our Code of Conduct to be more inclusive and reflective of our community's needs, we will be publishing this in January 2021.
