Nut-Free (and nut substitution) free school

We are a nut free school. This includes all products made with nuts and substitutions (such as WOW!butter). There are cases where an anaphylactic student has had a psychosomatic reaction to these products believing that they have been in contact with a nut product. It is also difficult for staff to have to determine what is and isn't true nut products (i.e., peanut butter vs. WowButter!) while on supervision at lunch.
