# **Parent/Teacher Conferences**

Just by way of follow-up, we wanted to make sure that we thank everyone who attended a Parent/Teacher Conference. Your participation in these conferences promotes student success. ## **Head Lice**

As we get into the colder months of the year, and there is the possibility of students sharing toques (despite home and school's encouragement to avoid this), etc., all students should be reminded of steps they can take to reduce the likelihood of getting head lice. Even though lice do not jump or fly, they can spread from one student to another by sharing combs, brushes, clothing, hats and more. Anyone can get head lice; all members of the household need to be checked when there is one case of head lice in your immediate family, or the cycle of treatment and infestation can be continuous.

- Follow the Bus Info link on the LKDSB website (top left of the website)
- Perhaps the best method to determine if buses are running, or if they are on time or running late, is this. Student Transportation Services offers the MySBI mobile app to receive instant notifications of school bus delays, and cancellations.
