#### SAFETY DRILLS

Over the course of this month, our students will be participating in safety drills: fire, tornado and lock down drills. While these drills can cause some wariness in our students, it is important to practice so that these procedures are routine in the event of an emergency.

# DRESS CODE

Dress codes help reflect a positive moral tone in the school and reduce social conflict and peer pressure that may be associated with appearance. Dress codes allow students to wear what they want, within the parameters of what is appropriate for

school, while leaving students with a sense of choice and expression. With the arrival of warmer weather, each family is asked to review the Student Dress Code with their children. We assume that parents are aware of and support the dressing choices of their children as they head off to school. To highlight:

- An opaque top and bottom are required
- All private areas are to be fully covered
- Undergarments must not be worn as outerwear
- Clothing and/or accessories shall not: o promote or symbolize drugs, alcohol, illegal activity, hate or discrimination, profanity, pornography
- o incite violence or harassment o pose a health and safety risk Thank you for your support.
