Automated Safe Arrival Calls & Absence Reporting

The Lambton Kent District School Board has implemented an automated attendance messaging system for our school. The system will notify parents/guardians if your child has been marked absent and the school has not been notified of the reason for the absence. To follow-up, we will contact the parent/guardian phone numbers that we have on file and ask that you call the school to confirm the absence and provide the reason. **Please note: To avoid calls and emails regarding attendance, kindly contact that school in advance to let us know your child will be absent. School voicemail messages are checked regularly.**

Bus Zones 7&8 - Inclement Weather

The Lambton Kent District School Board has administrative procedures, which will assist parents on mornings when dangerous weather conditions exist. Parents should listen to their local radio station or check the transportation website at www.schoolbusinfo.com or download the MySBI app by CLASS. **Please keep in mind during inclement weather if busses are cancelled in the morning, they do not run in the afternoon.**

Daily COVID-19 Screening Tool

We'd like to take this opportunity to thank families for completing the Covid School Screening every day. Keeping sick children home is our best defense against keeping Covid out of the school. We will continue asking for proof/verification of screening every morning to ensure that everyone is doing their part to keep our school safe for everyone. Families in Kindergarten to Grade 3 will continue to receive an email notification and verification each morning. Students in Grade 4-6 are asked to complete the screener at home and report their results to their teacher in the morning. PRICE OF MEALS

Food costs have increased, and we are trying something different. On some items to make them more economical we have offered them "a la carte", so prices range from **\$4.75** to **\$7.75** depending on what you choose. There are more "options" when choosing a meal. You can "upsized", "add fries" "add veg" "grilled chicken instead of breaded", change your meal to Gluten-Free, Organic, Vegetarian or Halal. We also added options such as "no sour cream", "no tomatoes" and so on for the children that don't like certain items on their meals.

CREDITS

Credits are now under the parent or email of the account. This way if your child was in grade 8 or changed schools the credits remain with you as the parent. It makes it easier for you since it becomes a family credit not a single child's credit.

Once you register your child online you will be able to see credits you have remaining in your account. Please use the same email for the account as 2020 since it is based on your email.

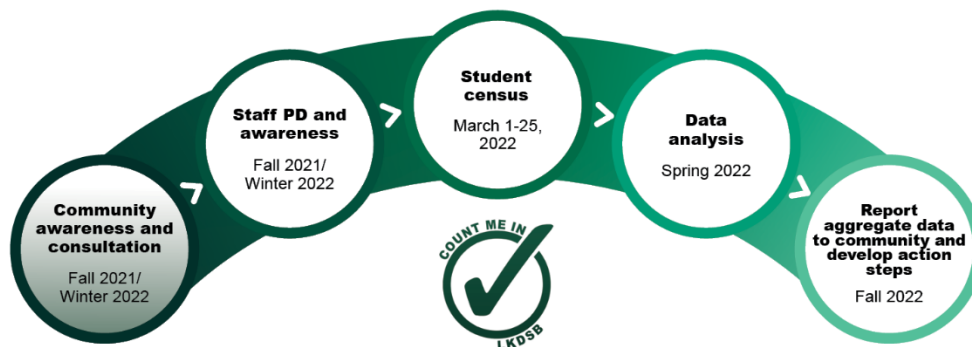
WHY DOES YOUR WEBSITE ASK FOR CREDIT CARD WITH ZERO BALANCE?
