Medical Information

Medication, both prescription & non-prescription, should not be administered to students by school staff. Specific criteria must be met for staff to administer prescription medication when it cannot be administered at home. An "Authorization for the Administration of Oral Medication" form, (available from the office), must be completed by the parent/guardian and physician, then forwarded to the Principal for each school year. This includes the administration of occasional use medications as well.

If your child has a prevalent medical condition (for example, anaphylaxis, asthma, diabetes, epilepsy), a specific prevalent medical condition form will need to be completed. The forms for this purpose are available on our school website. You can also send a note with your child, and we can send a copy home.

School Cash Online

With the LKDSB utilizing an online payment system in all its schools – School Cash Online – there is almost never a need to send money into the school (milk and popcorn are still cash sales at McNaughton). School Cash Online does not store any data, meaning that your banking or credit card information is never stored on the website, providing increased safety for you. It does mean that you will have to enter your payment information each time you use the service.

If you have not registered yet for School Cash Online please see the instructions below to do so:

Registering is easy (you will need an email address).

- a. Click Get Started Today
- b. Complete steps 1 to 3
- c. Confirm your account via email
- d. Return to the home screen
- e. Sign in by entering email address
- f. Enter password
- g. Click ADD STUDENT
- h. Select school from drop down menu
- i. Enter students name
- i. Enter students date of birth
- k. Enter your relationship to student
- I. Click submit

Once you register with School Cash Online, you will receive notices and reminders of items available for purchase or fees that require payment throughout the year.

Bus Zones 7&8- Inclement Weather

The Lambton Kent District School Board has administrative procedures, which will assist parents on mornings when dangerous weather conditions exist, such as fog at this time of year. If foggy, buses may be cancelled for the morning route, however students will be bussed home after school. Parents should listen to their local radio station or check the transportation website at www.schoolbusinfo.com or download the MySBI app by CLASS.

Absence Reporting

If your child is going to be absent from school, please call the school at **519-352-8252**. When you leave a message, include the first and last name of your child, his/her teacher, and the reason for your child's absence and when he/she will return to school. Our answering machine is available 24 hours a day for reporting absences. Thank-you in advance for your assistance with reporting any absences. You can also use the School Messenger app available on iOS and Android to report student absences.

All children are expected to attend school every day unless they are sick or off with parent approval. A parent can make a request, in writing, to remove their child from school for short term periods-under 15 consecutive school days (family reasons or vacations). An alternative program of study will not be provided for these absences. Students are required to complete regular program activities and assessments. Requests for absences over 15 days, in writing, will require that a program of study be provided and must be completed by the student. If a student is absent for more than 15 days without a written request or a program of study, the student will be removed from the school register.
