Re: Ministry of Education Capital Investment for Wyoming Public School

The Ministry of Education announced today a \$14 million capital investment in the Lambton Kent District School Board. As part of this investment, the Ministry has earmarked \$3.7 million for Wyoming Public School to support the creation of new pupil spaces, a daycare and gymnasium at the consolidated school site.

The Lambton Kent District School Board is also investing \$2 million in School Condition Improvement Funds for further improvements, including mechanical (heating and cooling) upgrades and classroom enhancements.

The total amount of funding for the Wyoming Public School site will be \$5.7 million.

This significant investment marks an exciting time in our school's history. The next step is for the Lambton Kent District School Board to begin the initial stages of design and tendering for construction and renovations at the Wyoming Public School site as soon as possible, with timelines to be determined.

An Ad Hoc Naming Committee for the Consolidation of South Plympton and Wyoming Public Schools is currently soliciting public input for the name of the new consolidated school.

We appreciate your support as we move forward with this transition. The Lambton Kent District School Board will continue to provide updates on this process as they become available. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to contact me.
