

Plympton-Wyoming School Letter

A Senior Letter will be presented to each grade 8 student who has achieved 100 points or greater at their June graduation ceremony. A student has two years (grade 7 and 8) to achieve this goal. Accommodations will be made for those students new to the school arriving after the beginning of grade 7.

Letter points must come from each of the following three categories:

- **Academic (Min. 30 pts. / 2 yrs.)**
- **Athletic (Min. 20 pts. / 2 yrs.)**
- **Participation (Min. 20 pts. / 2 yrs.)**

Academics

Students must earn 30 points minimum over the two years in the intermediate grades. The points will be allotted based on the June average for all subject areas at the end of each year using the following table:

Athletics

Students must earn 20 points minimum over the two years in the intermediate grades.

Students can earn three points per intramural activity or all-star activity with an 80% attendance. Students may earn 1 point for each all-star team they try out for.

Cross country team members will earn 6 points/season.

A *maximum* of 7 points may be earned for each year's track and field season. Each completed event at our school's annual meet earns participants one point.

School Spirit, Participation and Leadership

Students must earn 20 points minimum over the two years in the intermediate grades from any of the following types of activities:

- Library Helper (1 pt/term)
- Bus Helper (2pts/term)
- Lunchroom Helper (3pts/term)
- House Captain (1 pt/term)
- KofC Freethrow (1 pt)
- Gauss Math (1 pt)
- Science Fair (1 pt)
- Jump Rope & Terry Fox (1 pt)
- Intermediate Play (1 pt)
- Talent Show (1 pt)
- Attendance:

Less than 5 lates and/or absences for the year (5 pts.)

More than 5 but less than 10 lates & absences (3 pts.)

More than 10 but less than 15 lates & absences (1 pt.)
